## Planning for the Future Healthcare Workforce

### Purpose

Three years ago, several healthcare organizations sponsored a series of regional forums on the healthcare workforce shortage. The forums provided information on the nature and scope of the shortage. Participants began developing regional and state strategies for addressing the shortage.

The Regional Healthcare Workforce Forums in 2004 will provide updated information on the healthcare workforce. Many new workforce initiatives have been developed since 2000, and participants will learn about innovative projects in their region and the State. The second series of Forums will build upon the initial strategies and identify what else is needed to address healthcare workforce shortages and engage participants in long term planning for their region based on the data and information presented.

### Goal

To identify future workforce issues and potential strategies that impact the education, recruitment, practice, and retention of healthcare professionals in Minnesota.

Hospital, long-term care, home care, and ambulatory care administrators; pharmacists; human resource directors from healthcare providers; economic developers; legislators; public health and social service providers; chamber of commerce leaders; county commissioners; extension offices; K-12 educators; educational program directors from health professions programs; and local workforce center leaders.
