Financial and Operational Assessment, and Quality Improvement Project (FOA/QI) Reassessment

Purpose of Reassessment

The purpose is to update the Financial Operational Assessment (FOA) and Quality Improvement (QI) action plans to support sustainability. Reassessments are designed as follow up bench reviews and condensed action planning sessions (up to 4-hours) to assist healthcare organization teams with:

- Recognizing progress made and sharing of successes;
- Identifying additional performance improvements opportunities;
- Updating reports and action plans to leave teams with a roadmap to further support performance improvements after the organization graduates from the Program in September 2022; and
- Developing implementation technical assistance (ITA) projects.
