FORHP Policy Updates – November 9, 2016

- Emergency Preparedness Requirements
 - Critical Access Hospitals (CAHs) must follow similar regulations as other hospitals including:
 - Having a communication plan that includes information for other CAHs and hospitals or both;
 - Documenting the specific name and location of the receiving facility or other location for patients who leave the facility during the emergency;
 - Complying with current generator testing requirements (no additional testing would be mandated); and
 - Having a plan for how it will keep emergency power systems operational during the emergency, unless it evacuates.
- Providers have up to 1 year to implement the requirements

- Added Telehealth services for advance care planning and ESRD
- Separate payment for behavioral health integration provided by a primary care team (doc and behavioral health specialist);
- New Diabetes Prevention Program, payment starting in 2018

FORHP Policy Updates – Continued

- Inpatient Prospective Payment Systems (IPPS):
 - Withdrawal of the Two-Midnight Rule
 - Medicare Outpatient Observation Notice (MOON)
- Outpatient PPS Final Rule:
 - SCH 7.1% adjustment continues
 - Implementing Section 603 of the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2015 (site neutral payments) and the resulting moratorium
 - CAHs are exempted; however, all other rural hospitals may be subjected policy changes.
 - Removing the pain management dimension from the Hospital Value-Based Purchasing program to eliminate any potential financial pressure clinicians may feel to overprescribe pain medications.
