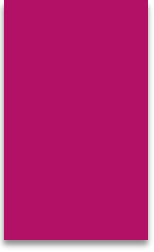

# Methodology: Top 10 States

- ▶ Data/Definitions:
  - ▶ Reporting was defined as reporting data on at least one measure with denominator of one or more for inpatient, outpatient, and EDTC, and reporting data with at least one completed survey for HCAHPS.
  - ▶ **Only MBQIP Core measures were used**
  - ▶ CAHs with no notices of participation were not included in this analysis.
  - ▶ Time Frame: Inpatient, outpatient, and HCAHPS data are from Q1 2016 through Q4 2016. The EDTC data are from Q1-Q4 2017.
- ▶ For each state, FMT calculated:
  - ▶ Inpatient, Outpatient, HCAHPS, and EDTC 'reporting percentage'
  - ▶ Inpatient, Outpatient, HCAHPS, and EDTC 'better performance measure score' (the number of measures on which CAHs in the state performed significantly better than CAHs in all other states)
- ▶ The Reporting and Performance Ranks were then summed and the Final Rank gives equal weight to reporting and performance across all four measure categories

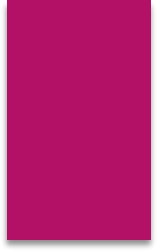
# Methodology: Most Improved

As indicated by the largest change in rankings in reporting, performance, and overall rankings across all domains from data submitted between Q1 2015 – Q1 2016 (EDTC Q1 – Q4 2016) to this year's rankings from data submitted between Q1 2016 – Q4 2016 (EDTC Q1 – Q4 2017).

- ▶ **2017 measures include:** 25 inpatient, 14 outpatient, 11 HCAHPs, and 7 EDTC measures
- ▶ **2018 measures include:** 5 inpatient, 10 outpatient, 11 HCAHPs, and 7 EDTC measures

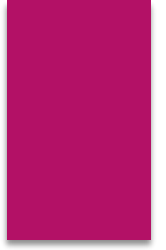

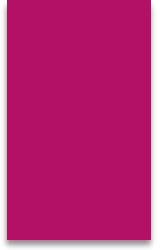
