# New resources with a focus on Social Determinants of Health

In cooperation with the Federal Office of Rural Health Policy, the <u>Population Health Portal</u> has been updated with new resources to **Get Motivated**, **Get Informed** and **Get Going** to navigate the journey towards improved population health.



The Data Tool focuses on specific scenarios for a hospital or county that allow users to analyze the data in the portal and also extract the data for further analysis in Microsoft Excel. The Data Tool includes three new scenarios and data updates to the six existing scenarios. Scenarios include explanations and instructional videos

on how to use and export the data. A new resource provides examples of analyzing claims data.
