All FORHP Programs collect PIMS

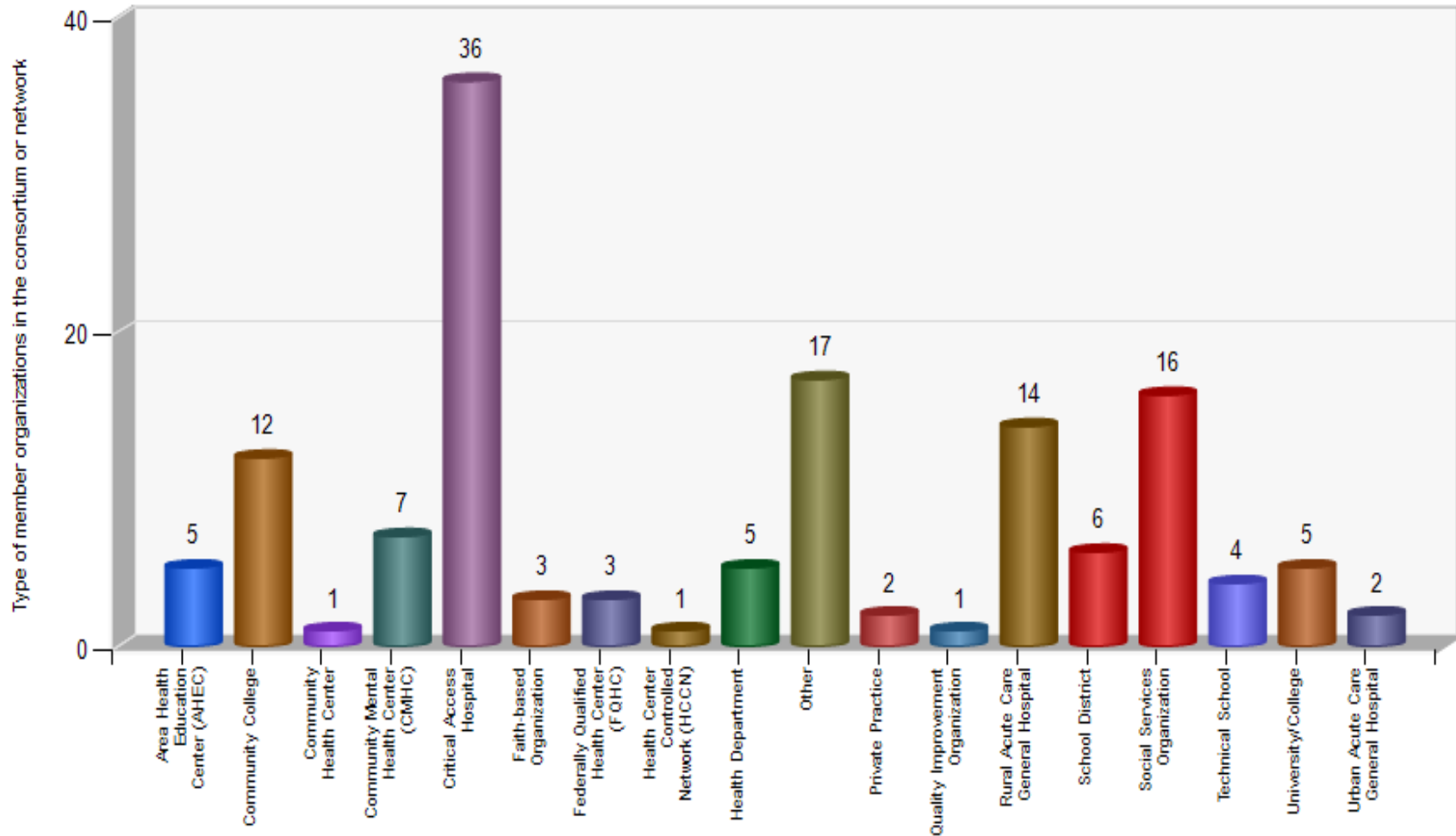


PIMS is especially important in determining viability of the Allied Health Training Pilot Program

Data helps quantify the impact of FORHP funding on measures such as:

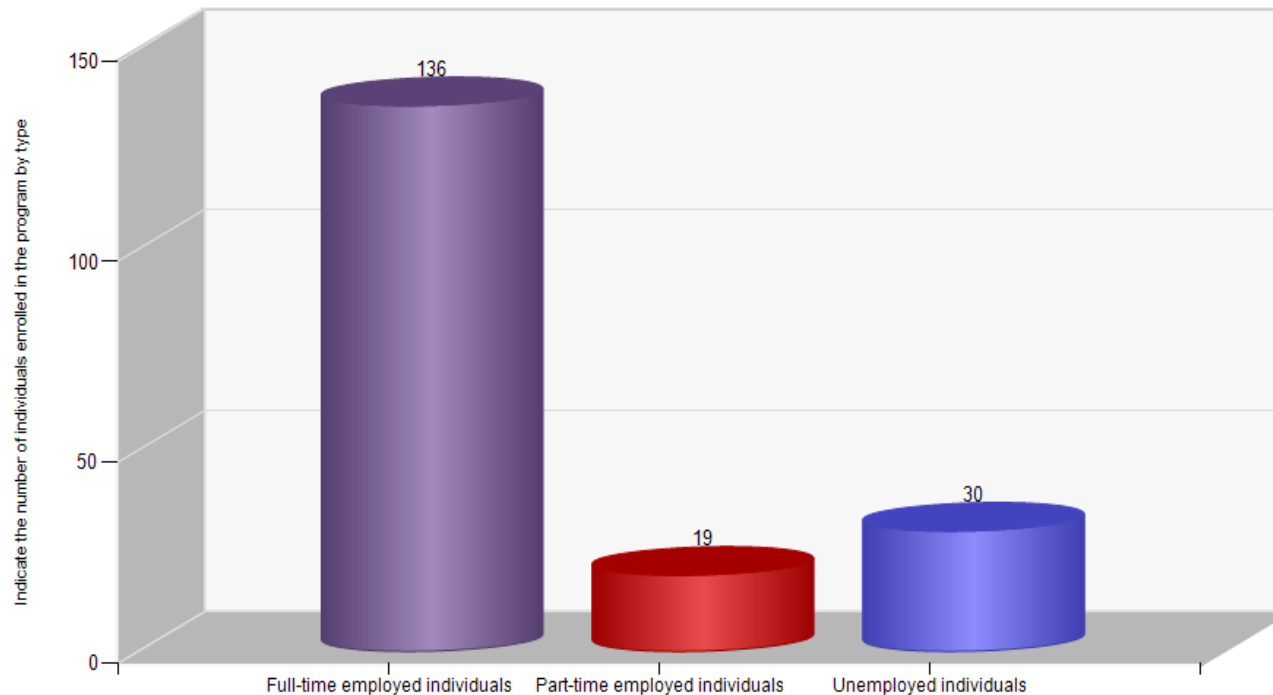
- access to care,

Indicate the number of individuals enrolled in the program by type





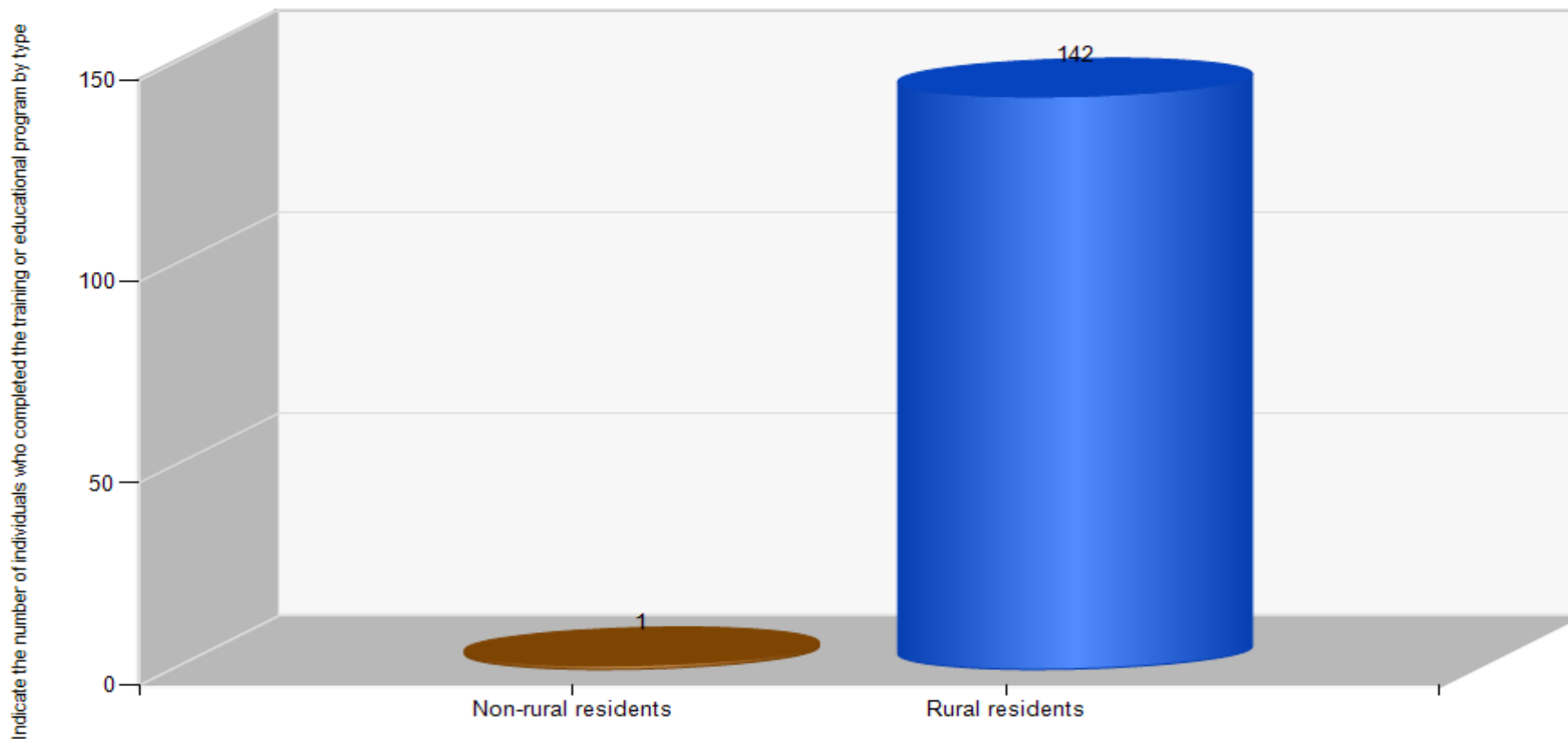

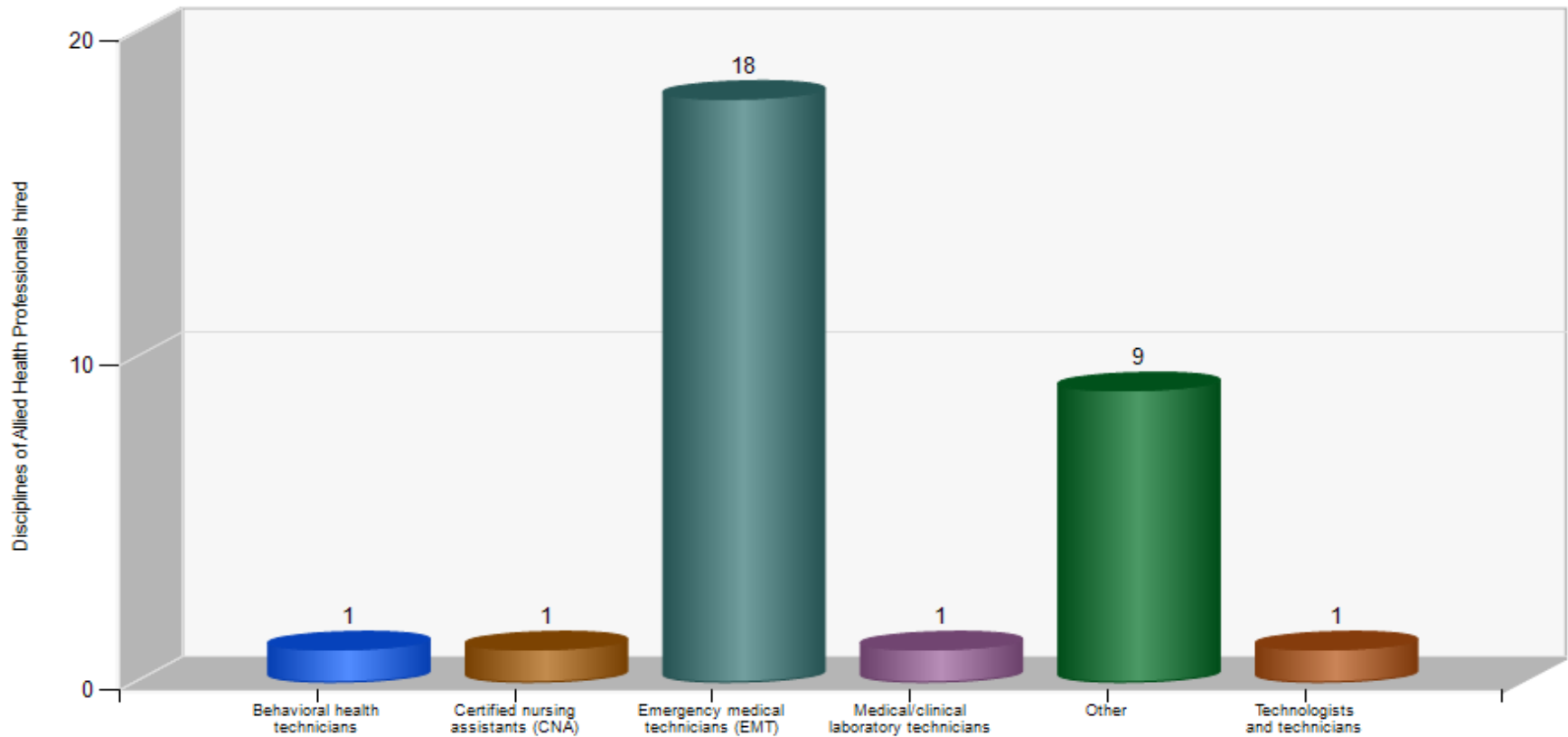


Number of Individuals who Completed the Training or Educational Program (e.g., associate degree) by Type	2015 - 2016
