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




Rural Hospital Network Size






Rural Hospital Network Staffing

What Business Are You In?

Facilitated Network

- Connecting people to share information and resources
- Typically paid by grants and/or dues per member

Value-Added Network

- Create and sell a product or service
- Typically paid by price per product or service

Solution Shop Network

- Provide expert advise
- Typically paid by fee per expert hour



Figure Out Your Units

- Facilitate network = members
- Value-added network = products/services
- Solution-shop network = expert hours



Forecasting with Units Makes Sense

- Illustrates the financial picture of each type of business product/service
- Provides an opportunity for comparison
