Key Concepts of SHIP

- Improve accountability and program integrity
- Projects/investments may complement the Flex Program
- CAHs can't duplicate Flex services
- Network hospitals to provide higher quality care by purchasing equipment/training at a lower cost
- Link SHIP purchases to measurement
- Expedite adoption of MBQIP, HCAHPS, ICD-10



Use of Networks in SHIP

- Networking hospitals (2 or more) is encouraged, but not mandated
- Flex networks may be used for SHIP and vice versa
- MOUs or contracts aren't required for network creation or operation
- ORHP is examining the efficiencies of networks

Benefits of Collaboration


- Discounts through shared volume
